Puppy Vaccinations

New Addition to the family? Make sure you're prepared for the necessary vaccinations to ensure your puppy is healthy and happy.

8 weeks = \$156.00

Exam- Our veterinarians will ensure your puppy is healthy enough to proceed with the vaccinations - **\$105.00**

DAP Initial - Protects against Canine Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2 (infectious canine hepatitis and respiratory disease) and Parvovirus - **\$21.00**

Deworming - **\$30.00** (approximate price - based on weight)

12 weeks = \$184.30 (\$212.60 with Lepto)

Exam - Another exam is required to ensure your puppy is still maintaining good health - **\$105.00**

DAP 2nd - Booster vaccine - **\$21.00**

Bordetella 1yr- Protects against kennel cough - **\$28.30**

Leptospirosis Initial - (optional) Protects against Leptospira bacteria (spiral-shaped bacteria that live in water or warm, wet soil. Symptoms range from flu-like to more severe life-threatening illness - **\$28.30**

Deworming- **\$30.00** (approximate price - based on weight)

16 weeks = \$154.30 (\$182.60 with Lepto booster)

Annual Exam- After this final checkup, exams will be followed up on an annual basis - **\$105.00**

DAP 3yr- 3rd a final booster. This vaccine is now effective for 3 years - **\$21.00**

Leptospirosis 1yr- Booster vaccine - **\$28.30**

Rabies Vaccination 1yr- This vaccination requires a follow-up booster in 1yr at which time will be effective for 3 years - **\$28.30**

Kitten Vaccinations

New Addition to the family? Make sure you're prepared to receive the necessary vaccinations to ensure your kitten is healthy and happy.

8 weeks = \$184.00 (\$282.95 with screening test)

Exam- Our veterinarians will ensure your kitten is healthy enough to proceed with the vaccinations - **\$105**

FIV-FELV testing – (optional) Screening test for viral diseases that can severely affect the immune system - **\$98.95**

FVRCP- Protects against Rhinotracheitis (a respiratory infection), Calicivirus (a respiratory infection), and Panleukopenia (a viral infection also known as feline distemper) - **\$21.00**

FELV- Protects against the Feline Leukemia Virus (infection that impairs the immune system) - **\$28.00**

Deworming- **\$30.00** (approximate price – based on weight)

12 weeks = \$189.00

Exam- Another exam is required to ensure your kitten is still maintaining good health - **\$105**

FVRCP 2nd- Booster vaccine - **\$21.00**

FELV 2nd- Booster/final vaccine - **\$28.00**

Deworming- **\$35.00** (approximate price – based on weight)

16 weeks = \$154.30

Annual Exam- After this final checkup, exams will be followed up once a year - **\$105**

FVRCP 3rd - Final booster - **\$21.00**

Rabies Vaccination- This vaccination is effective for one year, so when you come in for your next annual exam your kitten will require the follow up booster which then becomes effective for 3 years - **\$28.30**
